The artworks underscore the importance of discovering our true purpose and recognising that each of us is sufficient in our own capacities. All art pieces embody connected energies, inspired by nature, the cosmos, and everything within and around us, using only the word 'Allah'.

These artworks, over ten in number, combine acrylic on paper and canvas. They are based on the very first letter of the Arabic script, 'Alif', and the sacred name 'Allah'.
